

Editorial



It is a great pleasure for me to invite the whole power electronics community to join the European Power Electronics and Adjustable Speed Drives Conference (EPE'2007) held in Aalborg, Denmark, from September 2 to September 5, 2007 in order to exchange ideas/views on research progresses and technological developments in all related matters for power electronics. Denmark has during the last 20 years been through a change in respect to electrical power production and use. Today about 20 % of all electrical energy is covered by wind and further 30 % is covered by small combined heat and power plants which is a record in this scale. Further due to energy saving programmes the use of electricity has almost been constant even though production and population have increased. These issues will of course be addressed at the EPE'2007 conference which is sponsored by the EPE Association and will be held in the Aalborg Congress & Culture Centre – a perfect place for large conferences which is located in the center of Aalborg. the banks of the rolling Limfjord. We will also set up a spouse programme showing the beauty and the culture of Denmark. All presented papers will be included in IEEEExplore as we have technical co-sponsorships from major IEEE societies and the papers will also be registered in the Engineering Index. I hope to see you all in Denmark to make the conference a great success.
