

1. In Memoriam: Werner Leonhard



We mourn for Prof. Werner Leonhard.

Prof. Leonhard passed away on 16 November 2018 at the age of 92. After completing his doctorate at the TH Stuttgart, he worked with the Westinghouse Electric Corporation in Pittsburgh from 1954 to 58, before moving to Siemens in Erlangen. In 1963 he accepted the professorship appointment to TH Braunschweig, Germany (Institute of Technology). At the age of 36 he became the first director of the newly founded Institute of Control Engineering which he headed until his retirement in 1993. He developed the institute and led it to international success through his unresting efforts. For his master and PhD students, he was a highly motivating, committed doctoral supervisor and teacher. He created an open and intensive working atmosphere at the institute, which encouraged friendly cooperation and at the same time gave ample room for free scientific development. He supervised a total of over 600 diploma theses and 90 doctoral students. Even after his retirement, his scientific commitment continued with lectures and work in the field of electrical energy power supply. He was an internationally highly esteemed lecturer for invited

lectures and conference contributions.

Prof. Leonhard is well known among international experts and has received numerous awards, including the IEEE Mittelmann Award, the Honorary Doctorate of the Free University of Brussels, the IEEE Life Fellow, and the IEEE Newell Award. In 1985 he belonged to the closer circle of founding members of the European Conference on Power Electronics and its applications EPE together with Prof. Gaston Maggetto, Prof. Hansruedi Bühler, Prof. John Murphy and Prof. Rex Davis. He was General Chair of the EPE '89 in Aachen, EPE President from 1993 to 1995, holder of the Ring of Honor of the VDE and, in 1996/7, holder of the Heinrich Hertz guest professorship of the University of Karlsruhe. He has published many scientific papers and eight textbooks, including Control of Electrical Drives, which received great attention worldwide.

Through his numerous engineering works, from the beginnings in the still young field of control engineering with magnetic amplifiers to thyristor and transistor technology with analogue electronics to the use of microcomputers in electrical drive technology, he made a significant impact on technology through innovative impulses and, as a university lecturer, trained engineers who, like him, are committed to advancing their specialist field.


