

# Two Outstanding Awards for our colleague and EPE Committee member: Prof. Frede Blaabjerg

Two exceptional awards have been bestowed on Prof. Frede Blaabjerg: the "IEEE Edison Medal" and the "The International Energy Prize".

### The International Energy Prize

The Global Energy Prize annually honours outstanding achievements in energy research and technology from around the world that are helping address the world's various and pressing energy challenges. The Global Energy Prize, founded in 2002, is awarded to the most accomplished minds in the research world. ### The IEEE Edison Medal

On 11 February 1904, a group of Mr. Edison's friends and associates created a medal in his name to commemorate the achievements of a quarter of a century in the art of electric lighting. In their words, "The Edison Medal should, during the centuries to come, serve as an honourable incentive to scientists, engineers, and artisans to maintain by their works the high standard of accomplishment set by the illustrious man whose name and feats shall live while human intelligence continues to inhabit the world."
